Twice annually the Bibliothek Andreas Züst offers four studio residency stipends. The length of stay is a total of four weeks. Application for the Studio Residency Stipend is open to national and international cultural workers (individuals or teams of up to a maximum of four persons) across disciplines – visual arts, literature, new media, music, theatre, design, architecture, film, photography and art-related disciplines.

COVERAGE

The Studio Residency Stipend includes place of residence, workspace and meals. Travel costs will be covered. A separate request can be made for an additional subsidy for living costs of up to CHF 500. Each recipient of a studio grant will receive a Half-Fare travelcard for the public traffic in Switzerland.

CRITERIA

Applicants must submit a statement specifying their specific interests and describing their motivation in seeking a residency. The Bibliothek Andreas Züst is especially seeking projects that deal with the library as a whole or one of its sub-areas. The Studio Residency Stipend program is to be considered in the tradition of libraries as places of knowledge in the sense of diversity.

Application for the Studio Residency Stipend is open to national and international cultural workers (individuals or teams of up to a maximum of four persons) across disciplines who have an entry permit for Switzerland. Applications from families (compatibility of art and family, art and children) are welcome.

The stipends are awarded by an external Jury and representatives of the Bibliothek Andreas Züst. The jury's acceptances/rejections will be made by 5 November 2023. The decision of the jury is not an appraisal of quality and there will be no explanation of the outcome.
